

Decision Making Story

Learning Goals

Write a story about a school related issue or topic that requires decision making. Describe the consequences of good and bad decision making in your story. Your story needs to include the parts of a short story: setting, characters, plot, conflict, theme. (*Writing 2.1*)

Write using interesting language to tell your story, and to establish a voice. Your writing should use appropriate spelling, grammar, and punctuation. (*Writing 2.2, 2.3, 3.1, 3.4, 3.5*)

Use Comic Life (graphic story style) or Creative Book Builder (picture book style) to tell your story. Use appropriate and interesting images and text features (speech bubbles, caption boxes, amount of writing per box or page is short) to convey your story and message. (*Media 3.3, 3.4*)
